ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The City of Rock Hill seeks contractors for bids due by 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, November 17, 2011 in the Conference Room of the Operations Center, 757 South Anderson Road, Rock Hill, South Carolina 29730 for the City of Rock Hill, South Carolina, Lake Wylie Raw Water Intake Expansion – Phase I. Please note, the Operations Center has moved to a new location. The work to be performed consists of furnishing all materials and equipment and performing all labor necessary for constructing the proposed improvements as set forth in the Bid, as shown on the drawings and as specified. The work generally consists of constructing a raw water intake facility that includes one vertical turbine pump, submerged steel pump cans and associated valves, static intake screens, piping and a surge tank. The project also includes the installation of a chlorine vapor scrubber and related equipment. The majority of the work for the intake structure will be over water.
