#### Nomination Information for Rock Hill's Excellence in Historic Preservation Award

The City of Rock Hill and Historic Rock Hill work together to recognize significant historic preservation projects within the locally designated historic districts or locally designated individual properties. These projects may include but are not limited to:

- 1) Extensive restoration of an existing structure
- 2) Extensive architectural work to a non-historic building making it more architecturally compatible to the surrounding historic district
- 3) New or compatible reuse that maintains the architectural integrity of the structure
- 4) New construction built within and compatible with the surrounding historic district
- 5) Exemplary maintenance or impeccable workmanship of an existing historic structure
- 6) Extensive use of "green" building technologies in preservation work or new construction

All completed nomination forms must be received by April 1, 2010. Any individual, organization or project involved in the City of Rock Hill's locally designated historic districts or individual properties is eligible for nomination, and the work must have been completed within the past three years. Individuals or organizations may nominate their project for this award.

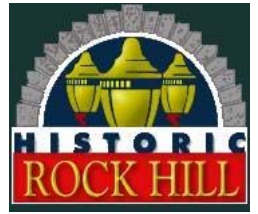
Nomination materials must include a nomination form and project narrative, and may include any associated materials that aid in describing the project, including photographs, newspaper articles, supporting documentation, letters of support, etc.

#### Judging Criteria

All nominations will be considered by the awards program panel. The panel will consider the impact of the project on the surrounding historic district, the quality and difficulty of the project, and the degree to which the project serves as an example of best practices in historic preservation. Nominees will be notified in writing prior to award presentation at Historic Rock Hill's Annual Membership Meeting in May.
