Gardeners with the York County Master Gardeners Association are available on Fridays at the Glencairn Garden Bigger House from 10am – 1pm to answer questions in person or by phone. Also during these times, soil samples may be dropped off for analysis. There is a \$6 lab fee for analysis which will provide pH and nutrient information. One pint of soil should be placed in a non-galvanized container. A plastic bag or container works well. Results are available within 7 – 10 days.

September Plant of Interest

Spider Lily (*Lycoris radiate*)



The Red Spider Lily magically appears in the Garden in August and September. Originating from Japan, they are also known as magic lilies, because they spring up overnight with no foliage.

Another name for them is naked ladies, for their long, slim stems with no leaves. The Red Spider Lily is currently blooming in the Founders Federal Relaxation Garden, the parking area on Crest Street and the Charlotte Avenue Showcase Garden.
