



NOTICE OF FIFTEEN (15) DAY PUBLIC REVIEW OF THE FY 17-18 STATE MASS TRANSIT FUNDS (SMTF) PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR THE CITY OF ROCK HILL.

I. The City of Rock Hill is offering review of the FY 17-18 SMTF Program Application. The SMTF program provides funding assistance for transportation options and services operating in the Rock Hill Urbanized Area. The City of Rock Hill contracts with the York County Council on Aging to provide demand response transportation services and with the Charlotte Area Transit System to provide an express commuter bus service.

The application is available for public review at the City of Rock Hill Planning and Development Department, 3rd Floor, Suite 300, City Hall, from 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday until April 18, 2017.
