- The City of Rock Hill will testify to the SC Capital Improvements Joint Bond Review Committee regarding Miracle Park. Pending a favorable hearing, all parties plan to finalize the Miracle Park agreement in October.

Master Plan Update

Commissioners toured the following outlying parks to view recent infrastructure improvements and discuss future projects:

1. Armory Park – Parking, Saluda Street access entrance and landscaping improvements made in partnership with Kenneth Monroe Transformation Center
2. Lige Street Park -- \$125,000 in FY2019 for improvements
3. East Moore Street Park -- \$90,000 in FY2018 for improvements, \$10,000 for vandalism repairs in FY2019
4. Friedheim Park – discussed recurring fence vandalism
5. Arcade Victoria Park -- \$100,000 in FY2019-2020 for improvements
6. Arcade A & B – improvements are planned within a larger park project scheduled for 2022
