Dial-A-Dumpster: Residential and Commercial Construction Waste Dumpsters

The City offers a variety of solid waste and recycling services to meet your specific needs. The Dial-A-Dumpster program provides businesses and residents with dumpster rentals available for cleanouts, construction / demolition debris and roofing shingles.

The City's commercial solid waste fees are competitive with and sometimes lower than the private sector.

The Dial-A-Dumpster service is available for \$90 each time the container is emptied. An additional \$90 rental fee will apply if the container is not emptied within 30 days of delivery.

The dumpsters are available in 4 yard and 8 yard sizes.



It is important to have a waste disposal strategy in place before beginning construction projects. Bulky items that cannot be collected at curbside include construction debris, bricks, rocks, concrete and dirt. These items will not be collected and could result in a fine from Environmental Inspections.

I already have Residential trash pick up. Can I put construction waste in my rollcart?

No. Bricks, rocks, construction materials, hazardous waste and yard debris are not allowed in rollcart containers and bagged garbage outside of rollcart containers will not be removed.

The Sanitation Department defines residential garbage as organic waste matter, both animal and vegetable, from kitchens composed primarily of waste food.

More about rollcarts:

Rollcarts are available through the Residential Garbage Pick Up Program offered by the City of Rock Hill. All garbage must be bagged and fit inside the 95 gallon rollcart with the lid closed.

Can I recycle construction waste?



Yes! Here are some ways that you can recycle construction waste locally:

Corrugated cardboard materials may be flattened and taken to red collection containers at City fire stations or your nearest York County Collection and Recycling Center. The County Collection Center will also accept other items for recycling including latex paint -- up to ten gallons per visit.



New and gently used building materials like doors, windows and fixtures can be donated to your nearest Habitat for Humanity.

Electronics may be recycled at the City of Rock Hill Operations Center at 757 S. Anderson Road, on Wednesdays, 7 p.m. until 3 p.m. We will accept anything with a cord, no major appliances please. Metal appliances can be collected for recycling upon request. Please call 803-325-2500 to request collection.
