



Criterion Course Regulations

The City of Rock Hill's Criterion Course is a 1.1 mile/22 foot wide paved bicycle course closed to vehicular traffic in order to allow cyclists at all skill levels to ride safely. This course is designed for both recreational and competitive cyclists. For your safety and the safety of others, please observe the following rules:

1. **HOURS:** Dawn to dusk. Entry onto or remaining on the course after closing is unlawful and a violation of City Code Section 21-1.
2. Course is for **BICYCLES** only. Anything other than a bicycle is **NOT** permitted with the exception of authorized staff and service vehicles.
3. This course is a **ONE DIRECTIONAL** course. For your safety and the safety of other riders, please ride only in the direction of the arrows.
4. **COURSE ETIQUETTE:** Slower cyclists should remain to the right of the course. Faster riders or riders who are passing another cyclist should ride to the left of the course. Cyclists are expected to be courteous to all cyclists, regardless of their skill level.
5. **HELMET:** Wearing a helmet is required. Cyclists must be head-phone free.
6. **PETS:** Dogs or any other type of pets are not allowed on the criterium course.
7. **CHILDREN:** Children under 12 must be accompanied by a responsible adult
8. No smoking, alcoholic beverages, glass containers, illegal drugs, fireworks, weapons or firearms of any kind are allowed on the property.
9. This course is owned by the City of Rock Hill and is maintained and operated by the Department of Parks, Recreation and Tourism. The City of Rock Hill is not responsible for accidents or injuries incurred while using this course. All cyclists use this course at their own risk.
