



Cherry Park, which opened in 1985, remains the cornerstone of Rock Hill's parks system. This 68 acre facility is a popular location for national, regional, state and local baseball and softball tournaments, while residents flock to the park year-round to enjoy the playground, athletic programs, and 1.5 miles of trails. A 14 foot bronze statue of legendary ballplayer, Mighty Casey, greets visitors as they enter the park.

Those visiting Cherry Park for a tournament may also spend time at two nearby parks: Hargett Park and Terry Complex at Winthrop University. These facilities provide additional softball and baseball fields for tournaments as well as for Rock Hill's youth sports programs.

Cherry Park may be the perfect location for your next family reunion, your child's birthday party, or a casual company meeting. The Covered Shelter is a great spot for outdoor entertaining, while the Indoor Shelter provides a rustic setting for informal gatherings. Let the kids enjoy the playground and blow out the candles at a picnic table nearby.

The catering services at Cherry Park can provide menu options for your group function as needed. For more information about facility rental, call the park office during business hours.

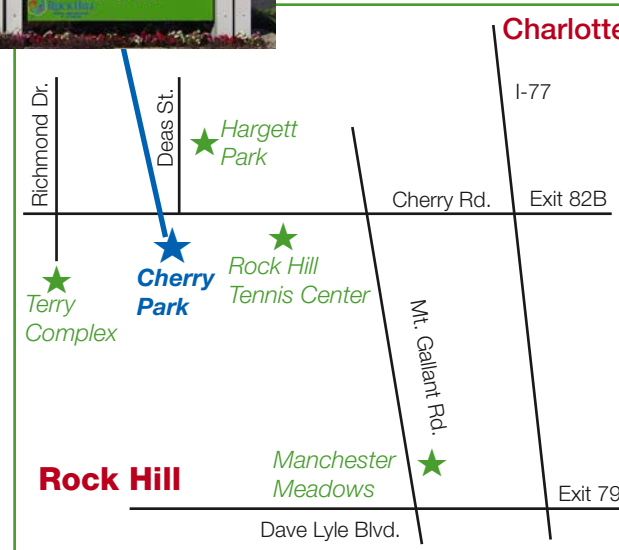

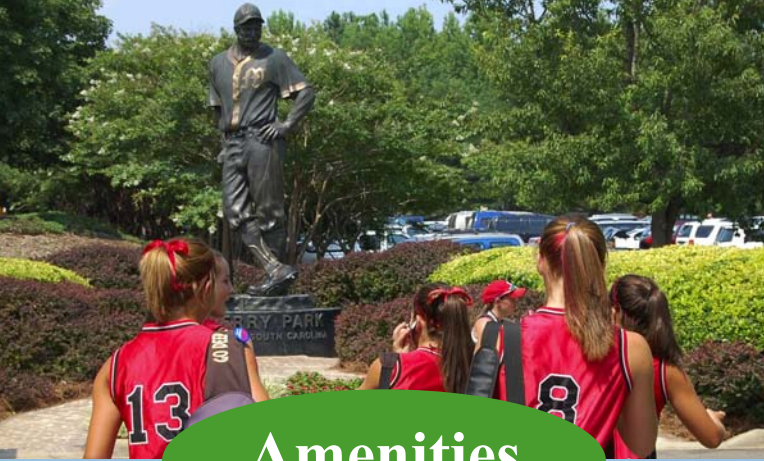

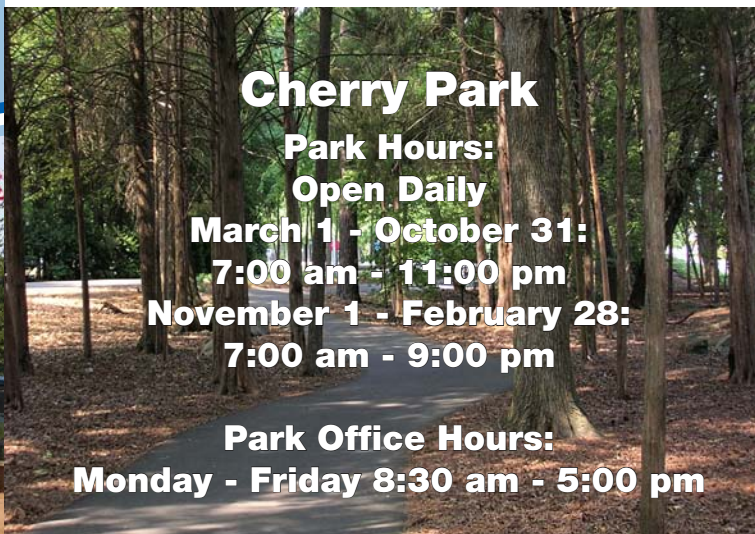
