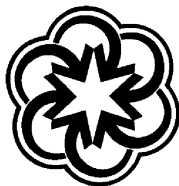

## Operating Hours

### 7:30am - 6:00pm

Fewell Park Center will open daily, Monday thru Friday, at 7:30am. Children should arrive no earlier than 7:30am.

**Discovery Quest** will begin regular programming at 9:00am, and cease scheduled activities at 4:00pm. Children should be picked up between 4:00pm and 6:00pm.

## Children Served

**Discovery Quest** serves children eligible for the 1<sup>st</sup> grade through the 5<sup>th</sup> grade. A child must be 6 years old prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> and cannot turn 13 years old prior to August 31<sup>st</sup> of the current enrollment year.

Rock Hill Parks, Recreation, and Tourism does not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, or national origin in its enrollment policies and procedures.

## Check In - Sign Out

...You are required to bring your child into the Center and sign in each morning, as well as sign them out at the end of each day.

You must enter the Center to pick up your child. We won't allow them to "run out to your car".

...**Discovery Quest** staff will only release a child to those listed on the registration form. You must inform the staff in advance if someone else is going to pick up your child other than those listed on the registration form. A photo identification may be required if the staff does not recognize the person picking up the child.

...These policies have been implemented for your child's safety. Please be sure and let us know when someone not listed on the registration form will be signing out your child.

## Late Pick Up

Children are to be picked up by 6:00pm. A \$10.00 charge after 6:00pm is applicable regardless of the situation. A second late pickup will result in a \$20.00 charge; a third late pickup is a \$30.00 charge. **These additional charges are payable prior to the child returning to Camp.**

## What to Wear - What to Bring

Wear t-shirts, shorts, and tennis shoes (no sandals). The children will probably get dirty. Sometimes, special activities will require different dress, but we will let you know about those activities well in advance. Hats also provide good protection from the sun when we're outside!

...**LUNCH**-Children should bring their lunch to camp each day. Pack a small cooler with your child's name clearly marked on it. We have a water fountain, but you may want to send a drink. No glass containers, please.

...**SNACKS**-There will be morning and afternoon snack time. We will provide participants with snacks.

...**Valuables**-Campers are responsible for their own belongings brought to Camp. Fewell Park will not be held accountable for items lost.

...**Cell phones are not permitted at Camp**

## **Accidents**

...Immediate treatment will be provided by Staff for minor injuries. You will be notified of the injury and treatment at the time of pick up. Should a serious accident occur which may need medical attention, the staff will contact you immediately so that you may decide treatment options.

...In an emergency, should immediate medical attention be deemed necessary by staff, 911 will be alerted, and you will then be contacted. The paramedics will decide on the course of treatment. Should they decide your child needs emergency care, they may transport him/her to the nearest medical facility.

...Staff at no time will be allowed to transport children in their personal vehicles.

## **Special Activities - Field Trips**

...Field trips and special activities will be a part of our regular **Discovery Quest** program schedule. Parents will be given adequate notice of these events. If applicable, there may be a small additional charge for some activities. All **Discovery Quest** staff will be required to go on these trips. All campers on site for that day are expected to attend planned trips. If you do not want your child to attend any scheduled trip, please make arrangements for alternative care.

## **About our Camp Staff**

...**Discovery Quest** staff members have been diligently selected, and are ready and eager to be at Camp with your child. Our staff may include school teachers, Winthrop University students pursuing a degree in childhood education, and local high school students. Each member of the staff is required by Rock Hill Parks Recreation, and Tourism to submit to and pass an extensive background check.
